

# Welcome to the 2010 - 2011 Lake Orion Marching Band Season

Dear Lake Orion Marching Band Parents and Students:

Please read the enclosed packet carefully – there are several pages that must be reviewed and forms that need to be completed. This will be the only packet you receive but it should be on the website soon.

## **Important dates to remember:**

- May 1 - **Registration Form and \$180 Non-refundable deposit, Emergency Treatment Information form, along with a copy of your insurance card (front and back), and Performance and Rehearsal Contracts due.**  
See checklist for all forms due at this time.  
(Note: you will be required to sign an updated contract once the dates and field availability are confirmed with the Athletic Department).
- June 1- 2<sup>nd</sup> payment of **\$100** due
- July 1 - 3<sup>rd</sup> payment of **\$100** due (fundraiser payout will go toward this payment)
- August 1- 4<sup>th</sup> payment of **\$100** due
- August 1 - Students in the following sections, **that will be using** school-owned instruments, will be required to pay a **\$75 instrument usage fee** due no later than August 1st: all percussion, tenor saxophones, mellophones, baritones, tubas and trombones. Colorguard uniform fee of **\$50** is also due no later than August 1.  
**(All payments through Aug. 1 must be paid in full in order to attend camp)**
- August 22-28- Band Camp at Camp Hayo-Went-Ha
- September 1- 5<sup>th</sup> payment of **\$50** due
- October 1 - **Final payment of \$50** must be postmarked or received by Band Boosters no later than Oct. 1 or a late fee of \$50 will be assessed. (Remaining fundraiser payout will go toward this last payment.) Note: Over-payment of total fees will be refunded to student/parent, as we do not carry individual accounts throughout the year.  
**(Final Payments received or postmarked after Oct. 1 will be assessed a \$50 late fee.)**

All other due dates are listed on your band checklist.

These costs are based on 155 students. Adjustments may be made if the number of students or schedule changes significantly.

# MARCHING BAND PAYMENTS

The cost to participate in Marching Band for 2010 is \$580.00. This fee helps pay for all marching band and BOA related expenses including camp, meals, transportation and staff. ***Please note that the actual cost of this program is heavily subsidized by the Band Boosters.*** Fundraisers will be made available for students to raise all or part of their fees. Students will also be expected to participate in fundraisers that will go directly to the Band Boosters general fund, i.e. entertainment books.

All payments must be up to date and paid to the Lake Orion Band Boosters, and deadlines must be met prior to attending camp. We are requiring a \$180.00 per student registration fee. **This fee is non-refundable** and will be applied toward the total marching band cost. This registration fee is **due no later than May 1, 2010**, and is required to hold your student's spot with the 2010-2011 Dragon Marching Band. Please refer to the payment schedule for payment deadlines. **Final Payments received or postmarked after Oct. 1 will be assessed a \$50 late fee.** Please keep in mind that monies raised through the available fundraisers will offset your payment amounts, however, the *payment schedule must be adhered to*. Checks or money orders should be made payable to **Lake Orion Band Boosters. DO NOT SEND CASH.** The option to pay by credit card is available this year. There will be a 3% processing fee for each payment placed on a credit card. All payments must be mailed with the accompanying forms to the Band Boosters post office box. ***PLEASE DO NOT GIVE PAYMENTS OR CONTRACTS TO THE DIRECTORS.*** We will not be responsible for any money sent into school with your student.

The Band Boosters and LOHS Band Department do not want any student deprived of participating in any band function due to financial difficulty. For those who qualify, financial arrangements may be made by contacting [treasurer@lodragons.org](mailto:treasurer@lodragons.org).

## MEDICAL HEALTH FORM

Included in this mailing is a health form, which will be carried on all Marching Band trips this Fall. It must be completed and then signed by a parent or legal guardian. We will also need a copy, front and back, of your student's current insurance card. This health form must be renewed on a yearly basis.

***No Signed Health Form = No Camp and No Trips this Season! No Signed Health Form also = no practice, although it will still be mandatory for the student to attend - they will have to sit and watch. If a health form is not on file for a student, their parent(s) will be contacted.***

## PRE-CAMP REHEARSALS

Pre-Season Full Practice: **All** Marching Band members are *required* to attend the pre-season practice June 21 – 24, at the High School from 1-8 p.m. There will be a dinner break from 4-5 p.m. Students are responsible for their own meals.

Pre-Camp Full Rehearsals: **All** Marching Band members are *required* to attend the pre-camp rehearsals Aug. 16 – Aug. 20, at the High School from 1-8 p.m. There will be a dinner break from 4–5 p.m. Students will be responsible for their own meals.

Wednesday Rehearsals: **All** Marching Band members are *required* to attend Wednesday rehearsals throughout the summer, starting June 30 and ending August 11, at the High School from 1-8 p.m. There will be a dinner break from 4-5 p.m. Students are responsible for their own meals.

Sectionals: Sectionals are **required** for all band members. See your section leader for days and times.

***Note: Please let Mr. Steele know in advance if there are any dates you will not be able to attend rehearsal.***



## 2010 LAKE ORION DRAGON MARCHING BAND CAMP

The 2010 Lake Orion Marching Band Camp will be held August 22 – August 28, 2010 (Sunday through Saturday) at Camp Hayo-Went-Ha in Central Lake, Michigan, located near Charlevoix on Torch Lake. All members will learn and perfect marching skills and memorize music and drill moves.

In addition to Lake Orion Band Directors, an expanded staff of qualified instructors will attend the camp to provide individual attention to students in music and marching skills. A large number of parents will also be going along as chaperones.

Facilities include a large dining/rehearsal hall, cabins (with electricity), separate male and female shower and restroom facilities, marching fields, a ropes course and zip line, volleyball and basketball courts and a water sports and beach area.

*It is required that all members who intend to perform with the 2010 LOHS Dragon Marching Band attend Band Camp.* The dates were made available several weeks ago. This was done so that family vacations and summer jobs could be arranged ahead of time. All members must attend camp because each individual relies upon the next. It takes every member's participation, including alternates, to make the band look and sound its best.

As we have done in the past, we will be transporting all band members to camp by bus. We are then inviting all parents to come to camp on the last day to join us for lunch and a performance on the camp field. This will serve two purposes – First, it will greatly offset the inflationary costs of transportation. **Parents will then be responsible for transporting their student home.** Where needed, the organizing of car pools is suggested. Secondly, and most important, the marching band camp experience is very memorable, as anyone who has attended before would confirm this. We hope to promote the sharing of something special between student and parent. We trust you will like the idea and call it fondly to mind afterwards.

### CAMP CHAPERONES

Band Camp cannot take place without the assistance of parent chaperones. This is a great opportunity for parents to see how the band functions. It is also enjoyable to watch and listen to the band take something from paper and put it into motion on the marching field. Without parent assistance we will not be able to hold camp. Please check your schedule for availability. **WE NEED YOU!**

#### Typical Chaperone Responsibilities:

- Ride the bus to camp with the students.
- Make sure students get up in the morning and eat all meals.
- Attend all meals with students.
- Assist in day and evening activities.
- Facilitate harmonious relationships between students in your cabin.
- Make sure students are in bed at “lights out” and stay there. This may include being on “patrol” occasionally.
- Enforce policies established by the Directors.
- Run errands for Directors as needed.

## What's New!

**Saturday Meals:** On the Saturdays that we have a competition, we feed the band a full meal before they board the bus. This is to ensure they are properly fueled for the day. Each section will be assigned a Saturday to feed the marching band. The menu will be provided, however, the parents of the designated section assigned that day will need to purchase the food, prepare, serve, and clean up. Please save your receipts for reimbursement. Wendy Becker is the person in charge of the menu, paper products, and meeting with the lead person for each Saturday. We started using this format last year with great success.

Your student has the opportunity to perform with one of the top marching bands in Michigan. We scored in the top 4 at State Finals in each of the last 4 years, placing 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2007 and 2008. This is a huge accomplishment. The students also have the opportunity to work with some of the top music directors and drill instructors in the state. However, there is almost no public funding for the marching band, so a large focus of ours is to raise money to bring down the cost per student. There are fundraising programs to earn money for individual student accounts and the general fund which goes toward all band programs. It takes an immense effort to take 165 students on the road competing for 2 months. It seems like a big commitment, but this program will build character and confidence in your student like nothing they have ever experienced. The directors cannot accomplish this without the parent support and assistance. There is an incredible amount of talent and skills among the parents, and there are many ways to participate:

Pit Crew \* Food – feeding hungry students and staff \* Prop Crew (no skills required) \* Concessions \* Fundraising Committee \* Chaperones \* Uniforms \* Plume Crew \* Communications - Public Relations \* Just show up – we will find something for you!! \*

**Benefit** - At a time when most teens are pushing their parents away, these kids actually *love* to bond with the parent volunteers and really appreciate our presence in their activities.

**Bonus** - You will meet some of the most amazing parents, creating a bond that will last a lifetime.

Please join us at the next booster meeting and get to know a few band parents that have your student's best interest in mind. The booster meetings are typically at 7:00pm on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month either at the high school or one of the middle schools. (We are starting to rotate through each middle school.) ## UNIFORM INFORMATION

As part of their uniform, all Marching Band students are required to wear a regulation marching shoe. Advance orders and a \$35 payment will be due by July 1, 2010 using the enclosed order form. If your student has shoes from last year, please have them try them on to be sure they still fit. A representative from the shoe company will be at camp to fit students that have placed orders for shoes.

Woodwind and Brass players are also required to wear black cotton gloves. Students will be given an opportunity to try them on, during rehearsals, prior to the July 1 payment due date. Advance orders and a \$5 payment will be due by July 1, 2010.

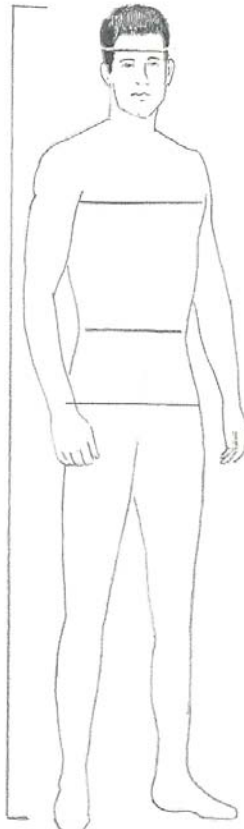
Uniforms will be distributed prior to each performance and returned when we arrive back at school. They do not typically go home with the students.

### Uniform parts and what they mean:

- Jacket: The uniform coat that is worn to football games and competitions
- Bibbers: The uniform pants that are worn to football games and competitions.
- Shako: The uniform hat that is worn to football games and competitions.
- Plume: The feather that is placed in the top of the shako for football games and competitions.
- Gauntlets: The black leather-like sleeve that is placed over the wrist of the uniform jacket that is worn to football games and competitions. We do not use these at this time.

### Measuring Guide

## Bus Rules

8. Maintain proper etiquette.
9. Proper hygiene at camp is a must. Students will be required to shower regularly.
10. You MUST be on time for all rehearsals. Disciplinary action will be enacted.
11. NO popcorn poppers, hot plates, or other large electronic equipment. Not only is the electrical supply to the cabins limited, but WE DO NOT HAVE ROOM TO CARRY THEM.
12. No silly string, shaving cream, balloons or air horns are allowed at any time at camp
13. NO bicycles, motorbikes, skateboards or cars are allowed at camp.
14. Band members will be placed on a work detail on a rotation basis. Details will consist of specific room cleanup and other assigned duties.
15. Cabins must also be cleaned before final check-out.

Stay to left through Kalkaska, turn left onto 72 W

Approx 3.5 miles: turn right onto Rapid City Rd. towards Rapid City and Alden.

Approx 9 miles to Alden

Approx 1 mile out of Alden turn left onto E. Torch Lake Dr.

Approx 5.9 miles: turn left onto N East Torch Lake Dr. Look for 593 sign

Approx 4.8 miles: camp is on your left. Use the second entrance on left "Drury", and then turn right inside camp entrance then bear left and around field.
