CONCERT DRESS *

Concert clothing must follow all the rules of the school dress code.

6th Grade:

6th Grade Band members wear dress-up clothes for concerts. This is not a uniform, so clothing may be any color you choose. All clothing must follow rules of the school dress code. In addition, please remember the following guidelines:

- No jeans or sneakers, please.
- Suggested wear for gentlemen: dress pants, a button-down shirt, dress shoes, and a tie.
- Suggested wear for ladies: A long dress or skirt (extending below the knees) with a nice blouse. If not possible, opaque nylons are recommended if a short skirt is worn. Dress pants are fine, too.

Intermediate Band, Concert Winds, and Cadet Band:

Gentlemen: black dress pants, white tuxedo shirt or white long sleeve oxford-style shirt, black socks, black dress shoes, and school-provided bowtie and cummerbund

Ladies: long (mid-calf or lower) black skirt or black dress pants (completely black), white tuxedo shirt or white long-sleeved button-down blouse with a collar, black nylons, black dress shoes, and school-provided bowtie and cummerbund or vest

For your convenience, you may purchase a tuxedo shirt and/or a long black skirt for your student through the large uniform order placed in late September - see the order form for details and due date.
